## MANDATORY CURFEW IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS from 10:00pm to 6:00am

At 3:00PM today, Mayor Teresa Heitmann signed a Declaration of Curfew in Residential Areas to begin tonight, October 3, 2022. The curfew will take effect beginning tonight at 10:00PM and continue each night through early morning until 6:00AM. The curfew prohibits persons (including but not limited to pedestrians, bicycles, automobiles, trucks, and/or using other forms of mobility) from traveling on residential streets, roads, and sidewalks within the City of Naples in areas that are predominantly single-family and multi-family residential areas.

The curfew does not apply to commercial and industrial zoned areas.

The curfew does not apply to essential service and first responders including but not limited to police, fire, EMS, ambulances, utilities, emergency calls by physicians and hospital services, including the transportation of patients to a hospital or care facility, people traveling to and from work, and residents returning to their homes.

The curfew will remain in effect until rescinded.
